Men's Health & Well Being Programme

Fife Men Project has been operational since 1997 engaging with people in public sex environments, supplying information, support and condom supplied.

Our aims are to provide men in Fife and surrounding areas with both information and support that enables them to make informed decisions that may influence the sex they have.

The project has worked and helped many men in Fife covering a variety of issues important to them. We have also established connections with many organisations throughout Fife to make them aware of the type of work that we do.

At our premises, which are located at the above address, we provide a confidential service for men who are looking to seek information on safer sex and resources including lubricate and condoms. We have in stock a range of leaflets covering areas of how to practice safe sex and how to prevent you from catching Sexual Transmitted Infections and lead an active life.

We work closely with services in Fife including the primary health care, GUM, the voluntary sector and the social work service of Fife Council.

We are looking for Outreach Volunteers who can provide information, leaflets and advise to men who are at risk from contracting sexual diseases from unsafe sexual practices. Active links have been made with the GUM clinics who practice total confidentiality in a gay-affirmative, non judgemental, professional practice.

We can provide the workers with the resources that they need and expenses that may occur travelling to potential Public Sex Environments.

A full accredited training programme with supervisory support will be available.

Volunteers will be expect to agree to Enhanced Scotland Disclosure Checks
